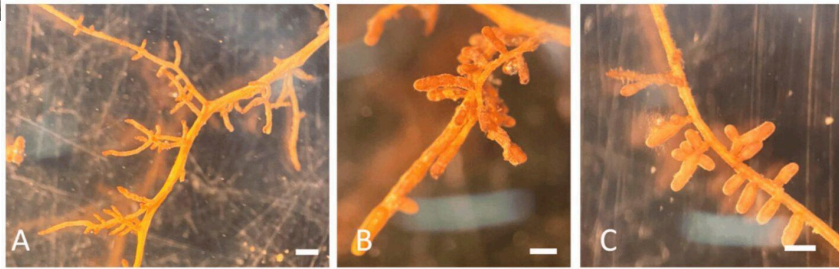


NATGA Microscopy Workshop, Wednesday, June 17, 9:00 am – 3:00 pm

Workshop Description:

Developed by Inga Meadows, PhD from North Carolina State, Scott Oneto from University of California, Cooperative Extension, and Ann Scanlan, NATGA Research Task Force Chairperson. This hands-on microscopy workshop will include instruction on stereoscopes and compound microscopes. It will cover root sample preparation, morphologies and identification features of different tuber species. Participants are encouraged to **BYOR**, or **Bring Your Own Roots** from your truffle orchard for analysis.
