1. Individual search work with each dog, including error correction.
2. Search work divided into the phases of Raúl Deoiz's "Metodo Salario" with a master dog.
3. Questions, answers, and discussion.

To get the most out of the experience and ensure the best performance from your dog, it's important to come prepared:

- ✓ Bring your dog without feeding beforehand, to increase motivation and engagement during training.
- ✓ Bring a crate or kennel, essential for rest periods and proper environmental management.
- ✓ Bring a leash and collar (or harness) to maintain safe working distance and structured exercises.
- ✓ Training treats and toys will be provided, but you are welcome to bring your dog's favorites to maximize motivation.
- ⚠ This is not a passive workshop. It is a dynamic, hands-on experience where you will actively work with your dog.

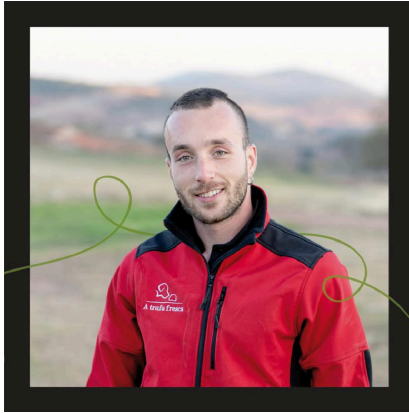
